

Who We Are

Reentry Care helps people returning from incarceration access healthcare quickly and successfully. We work with jails, prisons, probation, parole, and nonprofit reentry partners to connect individuals with licensed health insurance professionals who can assist with Medicaid and Affordable Care Act (ACA) coverage.

Our role is to ensure people leaving incarceration are connected to the right support at the right time, helping prevent gaps in care and improving reentry outcomes.

How Justice-Impacted People Use Our Service

- 1. Individuals complete a short <u>request form</u> requesting free health insurance enrollment assistance.
- 2. Reentry Care connects the individual with a licensed healthcare professional who can assist with coverage options and enrollment.
- 3. Individuals receive guidance on next steps so they can access care, prescriptions, and services as quickly as possible after release.

Why Partner with Reentry Care

More than 40 percent of incarcerated individuals have chronic health conditions. Connecting people to healthcare immediately upon release reduces emergency room use, untreated illness, and recidivism.

Reentry Care provides a trusted, reentry-focused pathway to healthcare access that helps corrections agencies and community partners improve outcomes, reduce costs, and strengthen public safety.
